# Instructions

## Guide to Safe Selling

- All scouts wear “Class A” uniforms when selling Holiday Greenery and again when distributing the greenery.
- Scouts stay in buddy teams, don’t go into unsafe or unfamiliar areas. Use your parents as your buddy system.
- Begin selling and distribution after 9:00 am daily, not earlier.
- Always remember the 12 points of the Scout Law especially when it comes to courtesy
- Please use the sidewalk and don’t run across potential customers front yard

## Using the Forms

- Be sure to put your name on all Order Forms, Summary Sheet and any Envelopes
- Write neatly and clearly on the Order Form
- For each customer, ensure you have accurately written on their order and Summarize each customer's total and quantity to the right in the yellow section
- Collect money upfront. All items must be pre-paid. Accept Cash or Check. Checks should be written out to “Troop 58”
- When you have finished selling, total each type of item sold per page at the bottom of the Order Form and the grand total for that Order Form
- If you have more than one Order Form, show that at the top right of the Order Form. *(For example, if you have 3 Order Forms, ensure each sheet is 1 of 3, 2 of 3 and 3 of 3)*
- When you have finished selling, use the Summary Sheet to capture the total of everything you have sold. Note that your Total Ordered and Total Money Collected must be the same

## Why Should I Sell Greenery?

- Earn income to fill your “Scout Bucks” accounts to help pay for trips or camps. You can earn up to 80% of the proceeds to go into your “Scout Bucks” after troop expenses
- A portion of the proceeds will also fund your unit's operating or capital accounts, meaning it can help pay for gear used on trips
